# Sermon Notes

When we feel like we're lost, how is one's outlook affected when we know someone is looking for us? Take some time to think about where you are in your relationship with Jesus: are you lost, are you found, are you trying to distract yourself, keeping yourself busy, or are you in need of a conversation with the risen Messiah right now?

Do things in your life seem like they happen randomly? Or do you feel like life is racing by like you're on a roller coaster? What are some important things that you feel God is wanting you to recall that you may have forgotten? Is there a unique theme that our Heavenly Father is telling through your life?

We are never so far gone that Jesus cannot reach us. The Prince of Peace does not get taken by surprise by our iniquities, but does call for us to confront our sins and to deal with them. What burdens do you need to confess and lay before Jesus, and what greater things does he want to replace them with?
