Sermon Notes

- 1) _____: “Just as We Are” doesn’t mean that we come to the Father on our own terms, but offering back to Him our very identity and being.

Is there anything that you have in life that you have not yet yielded to the Lord? What fears or anxieties prevent you from “surrendering all” to Jesus? What are you afraid of losing?

- 2) _____: When things are brought back in their proper relationship with the Lord, we are no longer trapped by old habits or ways of thinking nor do we remain oppressed by the powers of this world. We can begin to explore our lives anew in the power of Christ.
